### Write to your MP about:

- **The Aid Budget Cuts:** An appeal from Tearfund to ask your MP to take a stand against the cuts. The UK Government's decision to cut aid spending down to 0.3% of Gross National Income (GNI) - a cut of around £5.5 billion - is a devastating blow to the communities Tearfund serves. This will directly affect people living in poverty around the world. Families will go hungry. Children won't be able to go to school. Conflict will continue to ruin lives. - **The Assisted Dying Bill:** An appeal from the Evangelical Alliance to express your concerns to your MP. They say "Committee hearings in both parliaments have heard evidence from clinicians, lawyers and academics. Many have outlined the harms each bill would have on the elderly, people living with a disability, women and minority ethnic communities. There are no safeguards to protect patients from a miscarriage of care and both bills must be rejected!"
