Ellie and Liz will talk about neurodivergent brains and how neurodiversity (eg Autism, ADHD, Dyslexia, Dyspraxia etc) can impact childhood, thinking about what skills neurodivergent children have, and what challenges they may face.

They will talk about navigating school when you are neurodivergent, and will think about parenting neurodivergent children.

Dr Liz Beckingham is a Clinical Psychologist with additional training in family therapy, and works in the NHS supporting children, young people and families who are struggling. She works privately at Headspace Guildford, on the therapy and autism assessment pathways.

Dr Ellie Atkins is a Consultant Clinical Psychologist and Lead Psychologist for Neonatal Care in London. She runs a private practice, Headspace Guildford, which she set up in 2011, and supports children, youngsters and families who are struggling with their mental health and wellbeing. She offers autism assessments, and is currently writing a book on parenting children who are neurodivergent, which will be out in 2026.
