The talk will cover some key points about what neurodivergence is, focusing primarily on ADHD & Autism. We will be debunking some common myths, exploring some of the challenges neurodivergent people and their loved ones may face, as well as looking at some of the joys & strengths which come along with these conditions. We will have a focus on 'living well' with neurodivergence, with a view to thriving in life, rather than just surviving, and signposting to further support will be provided.

The morning will be led by Dr Jenna McKeown, a Clinical Psychologist with over 10 years post-qualification in the NHS and Private Practice. Her work involves assessment and therapy for people with all kinds of mental illnesses, and in her private work she carries out assessments of ADHD and offers post diagnostic support and therapy.
